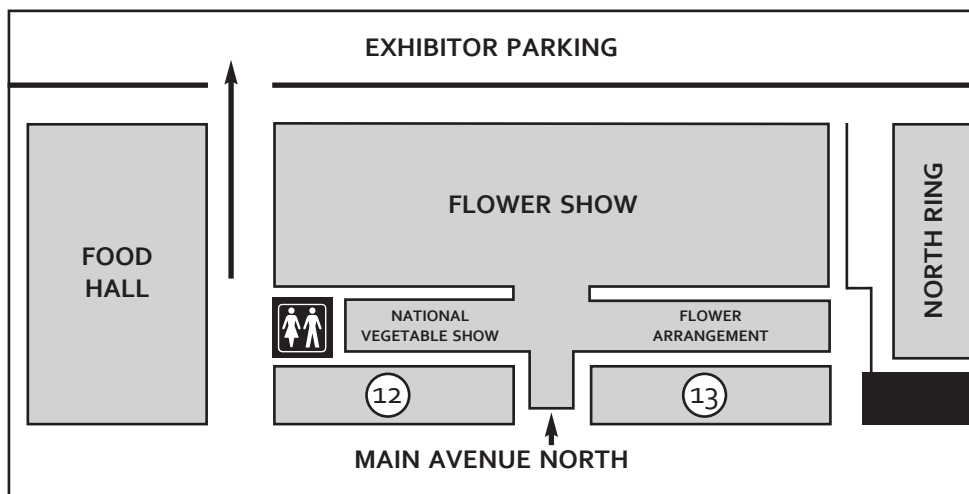

# NEW FOREST SHOW - OPEN SHOW

## SECTION A: VEGETABLE CLASSES

### **Class 1 SOUTH OF ENGLAND POTATO CHAMPIONSHIP**

Collection of three dishes of potatoes of three distinct varieties, five potatoes in each dish.  
**Prize money: 1st £50; 2nd £30; 3rd £20 and 4th £10, plus perpetual trophy and shield.**

### **Class 2 NEW FOREST SHOW TOP TRAY**

Collection of three types of vegetables on a tray of approximately 45cm x 60cm.  
Numbers as in classes 3 to 14. Staging and garnishing permitted.  
**Prize money: 1st £20; 2nd £15; 3rd £10 and 4th £5.**

**Class 3 Onions** - one dish of three, over 250 grams but not exceeding 1.5 kilos.

**Class 4 Potatoes** - one dish of four and variety or colour

**Class 5 Rhubarb** - unforced - one dish of three sticks

**Class 6 Runner Beans** - one dish of six

**Class 7 Shallots** - exhibition, one dish of six

**Class 8 Carrots** - other than long, with not more than 75mm leaf stalk, one dish of three

**Class 9 Tomatoes** - approximately 65mm in diameter, one dish of four

**Class 10 Courgettes** - one dish of three

**Class 11 Beetroot** - globe with not more than 75mm leaf stalk, one dish of three

**Class 12 Collection of fresh herbs for culinary use** - four distinct kinds (named) in separate vases. Vases not supplied

**Class 13 Marrows** - one dish of two

**Class 14 Cherry Tomatoes** – one dish of fifteen

**Class 15 Soft Fruit** – a dish of one cultivar quantity's as stated in RHS handbook

**Prize money for classes 3 to 15: 1st £7; 2nd £5 and 3rd £3.**

**Class 16 THE MASTER GARDENER** - a collection of Flowers, Fruit & Vegetables

To be staged in a space not exceeding 75cm x 150cm, to consist of: one vase of flowers with no additional foliage, 6 stems of one variety, two dishes of fruit & two dishes of vegetables (worth 18 points or less) numbers as per single classes in the RHS handbook. **Prize money: 1st £20; 2nd £15 and 3rd £10..**

## THE NATIONAL VEGETABLE SOCIETY 2011 SOUTHERN BRANCH CHAMPIONSHIPS - OPEN TO NVS MEMBERS ONLY

### SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

- Class 1** **Collection.** Five kinds of vegetables, number and kinds to be chosen from Classes 3 to 20. Space allowed 1.2m x 1.2m approximately. Staging and garnishing permitted  
**Prize money: 1st £50; 2nd £30; 3rd £20 and 4th £10**
- Class 2** **Cabbage** - one dish of two with a minimum of 75mm stalks
- Class 3** **Celery** - one dish of two heads
- Class 4** **Parsnips** - one dish of three
- Class 5** **Leeks** - blanch and intermediate, one dish of three
- Class 6** **Carrots** - long pointed, one dish of three
- Class 7** **Onions** - large exhibition, one dish of three
- Class 8** **Peas** - one dish of nine
- Class 9** **Cauliflowers** - one dish of two
- Class 10** **Potatoes** - white, one dish of five
- Class 11** **Potatoes** - coloured, one dish of five
- Class 12** **Carrots** - stump rooted, one dish of three
- Class 13** **Onions** - not to exceed 250grms, one dish of five
- Class 14** **Runner Beans** - one dish of nine
- Class 15** **Tomatoes** - approximately 60mm in diameter, one dish of five
- Class 16** **Shallots** - pickling, not to exceed 30mm in diameter, one dish of twelve
- Class 17** **Shallots** - exhibition, one dish of twelve
- Class 18** **Beetroots** - globe, one dish of three
- Class 19** **Cucumbers** - one dish of two
- Class 20** **French Beans** - one dish of twelve

**Prize money for Classes 2 to 20: 1st £10, 2nd £6 and 3rd £4**

**Entry is free to all fully paid up members of The National Vegetable Society**

## SECTION B AWARDS

- The Cedric Haytor Trophy**      Awarded to the winner of Class 1, Vegetable Collection
- The Holderness Spade Trophy**      which this year is given to Class 5, Leeks
- The Holderness Fork Trophy**      which this year is given to Class 6, Carrots long pointed
- Best in Show Award**      Awarded by the Judges to the best exhibit from Classes 2 to 20 in the Show
- Show Champion**      Awarded to the person gaining the most points in the Show

## **RULES FOR SECTION A: VEGETABLE CLASSES**

1. The Show secretary reserves the right to refuse entry to any exhibitor without explanation. As per RHS rules.
2. Exhibits will be judged in accordance with the RHS Rules where applicable.
3. Staging of exhibits will be between 6.00pm on Monday 25th July 2011 throughout the night until 8.00am on Tuesday 26th July 2011.
4. Judging will commence at 8.00am, concluding at 10.00am on Tuesday, 26th July 2011. Only Judges, Stewards and Officials are allowed in the Show Marquee during the judging. The Show will open to the public at 10.15am on Tuesday, 26th July 2011.
5. Prize money vouchers can be collected from the Show secretary following completion of judging.
6. Entry forms must reach the Show Secretary by the stated time.
7. Closing date for entries will be Wednesday 20th July 2010. No late entries will be accepted (this is because there would not be enough time to process your entry and send out your ticket).
8. Exhibitors will be allowed entry to the Show during staging by displaying the exhibitors' car park pass. Clearance tickets will be issued by the show secretary on the first day of the show.
9. The handling of exhibits once staged or after judging is forbidden. Under no circumstances will any exhibit be allowed to be removed from the tables once judging has been completed, until the official lifting time of 4.30pm on Thursday, 28th July 2011. Any exhibits that remain uncollected will be auctioned for charity.
10. In section 'A' staging is not provided, with the exception of class 1. Exhibitors may use their own staging in accordance with RHS guidelines.
11. Only one entry per Exhibitor per Class allowed.

## **RULES FOR SECTION B: NVS SOUTHERN BRANCH CHAMPIONSHIPS**

1. The Championships are open to all individual NVS members and ONE member of an affiliated society.
2. Judging will be to the rules laid down by The National Vegetable Society.
3. Staging of exhibits will be between 6.00pm on Monday, 25th July 2011 throughout the night until 8.00am on Tuesday, 26th July 2011.
4. Judging will commence at 8.00am, concluding at 10.00am on Tuesday, 26th July 2011. Only Judges, Stewards and Officials are allowed in the Show Marquee during the judging. The Show will open to the public at 10.15am on Tuesday, 26th July 2011.
5. Trophies and prize money vouchers will be available from the show secretary following completion of judging.
6. Entry forms must reach the Show Secretary by the stated time.
7. Closing date for entries will be Wednesday 20th July 2011. No late entries can be accepted (this is because there would not be enough time to process your entry and send out your ticket).
8. Entry to the Show will be by ticket only. One "any day" ticket will be sent out by first class post prior to the event. You will also receive a pass to the Exhibitor's car park and a map of the Showground.
9. The handling of exhibits once staged or after judging is forbidden. Under no circumstances will any exhibit be allowed to be removed from the tables once judging has been completed, until the official lifting time of 4.30pm on Thursday, 28th July 2011. Any exhibits that remain uncollected will be auctioned for charity.
10. All plates, dishes, sand and boards etc will be supplied and must be the ones used. Exhibitors may use own staging for Class1.
11. Only one entry per Exhibitor per Class allowed.
