THEME: "WILD AND WONDERFUL"

Please read "On With The Show" fifth edition 2008

CLASSES

1. WILD FRUIT JELLY

Presented in a small glass jar no larger than 225g/8oz.

2. HERB SCONES

Three savoury scones (incorporating herbs of your choice) to be exhibited on an oblong board approximately 20cms/8".

3. FOUR SEASONS CUP CAKES

Four cup cakes decorated to represent the four seasons presented on a circular disposable plate.

4. PRODUCE CO-OPERATIVE

A Wonderful Christmas basket for one (select three items from the following – jar of chutney/confectionery/sweet mincemeat/preserve/shortbread). The basket overall size no larger than 46cms/18" wide. At least three members to take part. The basket to come to the Show ready for judging and display. Marks will be awarded for staging and interpretation.

5. KNITTING / CROCHET

A hand knitted Wild and Whacky tea cosy. Any pattern, perhaps your own design and any yarn.

6. AN ANIMAL DOORSTOP

Any craft can be used.

7. NOVICE CLASS (The Elsie Littlefield Trophy)

A piece of jewellery from plant/natural material. For a WI Member who has not previously won a 1st prize in a Craft Class at the New Forest and Hampshire County Show.

8. CRAFT CO-OPERATIVE

A Wonderful Book to be displayed with three different relevant crafts. To be displayed on a board no larger than 61cms deep x 77cms wide (24" x 30") to be viewed from the front. Accessories may be used. Marks will be awarded for staging and interpretation. At least three members to participate but only two to stage on Monday 25th July.

9. FLOWERS

'Wild Fire' – a fresh display on a base no larger than 31cms/12" square. Any height in keeping with your arrangement. Overall width no greater than 46cms/18". This exhibit to arrive at the Showground ready assembled. A suitable neutral background will be provided.

10. PHOTOGRAPH

'Our Wonderful Forest'. Your photograph should be no larger than 18cms x 13cms (7" x 5"). Mounted and ready to hang. NO clip frames please. Portrait or Landscape style.

11. ART

'Let's Go Wild' – a painting using any medium – but nothing sewn or stitched. This entry to be framed and ready to hang. NO clip frames please.

12. COMMITTEE CUP

A vertical hanging of six 6" (15cms) squares using the fabric provided. Each square displaying a different craft of your choice. The top square to have a sleeve attached at the top (on the back) to allow the hanging to be displayed in our marquee. An opportunity for possibly six members to participate. This class will be judged by the public.

RULES

1. Competitors must be WI members.
2. Articles for competition must be the Competitor's own work since August 2010. Craft garments must not have been worn or used.
3. Entry forms should be sent through Members' Institute Secretary.
4. Competitors can enter any number of items but can take only one award in each class.
5. Right is reserved to withhold the first prize if the Judge considers the work does not merit it.
6. The Judge's decision is final.
7. All exhibits including Co-operatives must be checked in between 9.00am and 11.00am on the day before the Show – Monday, 25th July 2011.
8. Exhibits, apart from the Co-operatives, will be staged at the Committee's discretion.
9. Entries close Friday, 17th June 2011. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.
10. Exhibits may not be dismantled or removed from the Showground until 6.30pm but before 7.30pm having been CHECKED OUT on the final day (Thursday 28th July 2011).
11. Any Show comments to be sent to Mrs S Pope, 22 Dibden Lodge Close, Hythe, SO45 6AY within 14 days.

AWARDS

CERTIFICATES will be awarded for Classes 1 – 11.

CLASSES 4 & 8 (the Co-operative Classes) will receive a Co-operative Cup and a Denman Bursary for the 1st Prize; a 2nd Prize £10 and a 3rd Prize of £7.50 will be awarded.

CLASS 12 will be awarded the Committee Cup to the WI receiving the highest number of votes from the Public participation.

The Denman College Bursaries and Awards for Best in Show in Craft and Produce are sponsored by the WI Tent Committee.

Individual entries and Class 12 – 50p per entry. Co-operative Classes (4 & 8) - £4.00.

Articles for sale must be securely labelled showing price and member's name and a list in duplicate handed in with the goods. Items to be brought to the Show Tent between 10am and 4pm on Monday 25th July 2011.

Unsold articles should be collected between 6.15pm and 7.15pm on the last day of the Show.
