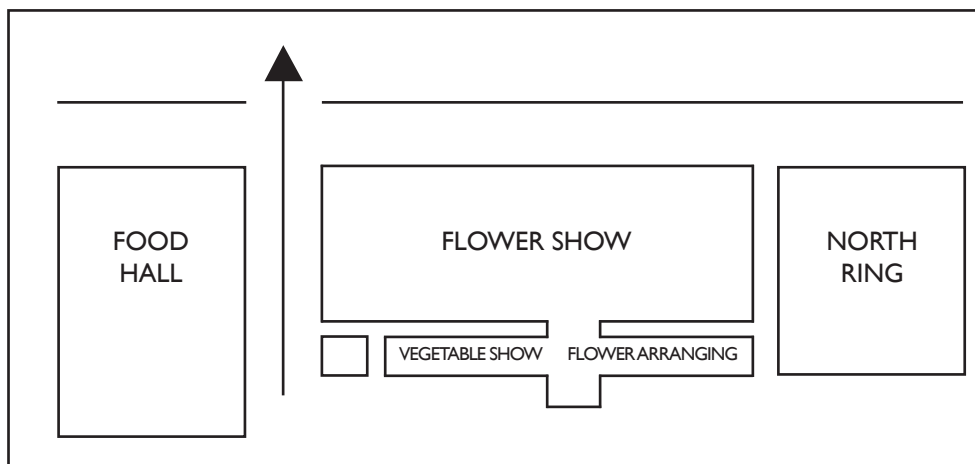

# NEW FOREST SHOW - OPEN SHOW

## SECTION A: VEGETABLE CLASSES

- Class 1 SOUTH OF ENGLAND POTATO CHAMPIONSHIP (Sponsored By J.B.A Seed Potatoes Ltd). Collection of three dishes of potatoes of three distinct varieties, five potatoes in each dish. Prize money: 1st £70; 2nd £45; 3rd £30 and 4th £15, plus perpetual trophy and shield.
- Class 2 NEW FOREST SHOW TOP TRAY. Collection of three types of vegetables on a tray of approximately 45cm x 60cm. Number as in classes 4 to 13 only. Staging and garnishing permitted. Prize money: 1st £25; 2nd £20; 3rd £15 and 4th £10.
- Class 3 Rhubarb - unforced - one dish of three sticks.
- Class 4 Potatoes - one dish of four any variety or colour.
- Class 5 Onions - one dish of three, over 250 grams but not exceeding 1.5 kilos.
- Class 6 Runner Beans - one dish of six.
- Class 7 Shallots - exhibition, one dish of six.
- Class 8 Carrots - stump rooted, with not more than 75mm leaf stalk, one dish of three.
- Class 9 Tomatoes - approximately 60mm in diameter, one dish of four.
- Class 10 Courgettes - one dish of three.
- Class 11 Beetroot - globe with not more than 75mm leaf stalk, one dish of three.
- Class 12 Marrows - one dish of two.
- Class 13 Cherry Tomatoes - one dish of fifteen.
- Class 14 Broad Beans - one dish of six.
- Class 15 Collection Of Fresh Herbs For Culinary Use - four distinct kinds (named) in separate vases. Vases not supplied.
- Class 16 Soft Fruit - a dish of one cultivar quantity's as stated in RHS handbook.
- Class 17 MASTER GARDENER - a collection of flowers, fruit & vegetables. To be staged in a space not exceeding 75cm x 150cm, to consist of: one vase of flowers with no additional foliage, six stems of one kind, fruit two dishes; vegetables (18 points or under), two dishes. Numbers as per single classes in the RHS handbook.  
Prize money: 1st £20; 2nd £15 and 3rd £10.

Prize money for classes 3 to 16: 1st £11; 2nd £9 and 3rd £7

Entry is free and open to all

### SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

- Class 1 **Collection** - five kinds of vegetables, number and kinds to be chosen from classes 3 to 21. Space allowed 1.2m x 1.2m approximately. Staging and garnishing permitted.  
Prize money: 1st £55; 2nd £35; 3rd £25 and 4th £15.
- Class 2 The DT BROWN Collection - A collection of three kinds of vegetable, two of each kind from any 20 point vegetables. Space allowed not greater than 75cm frontage.  
Prize money: 1st £55; 2nd £35; 3rd £25 and 4th £15.
- Class 3 Cabbage - one dish of two with a minimum of 75mm stalks.
- Class 4 Celery - one dish of two heads.
- Class 5 Parsnips - one dish of three.
- Class 6 Leeks - blanch or intermediate, one dish of three.
- Class 7 Carrots - long pointed, one dish of three.
- Class 8 Onions - large exhibition, one dish of three.
- Class 9 Peas - one dish of nine.
- Class 10 Cauliflowers - one dish of two.
- Class 11 Potatoes - white, one dish of five.
- Class 12 Potatoes - coloured, one dish of five.
- Class 13 Carrots - stump rooted, one dish of three.
- Class 14 Onions - not to exceed 250grms, one dish of five.
- Class 15 Runner Beans - one dish of nine.
- Class 16 Tomatoes - approximately 60mm in diameter, one dish of six.
- Class 17 Shallots - pickling, not to exceed 30mm in diameter, one dish of twelve.
- Class 18 Shallots - exhibition, one dish of twelve.
- Class 19 Beetroots - globe, one dish of three.
- Class 20 Cucumbers - one dish of two.
- Class 21 French Beans - one dish of twelve.  
Prize money for Classes 3 to 21: 1st £14, 2nd £11 and 3rd £8
- Class 22 Marshalls' Satelit, French Bean Class - one dish of 9  
Prize money for Class 22: 1st £75, 2nd £15, 3rd £10

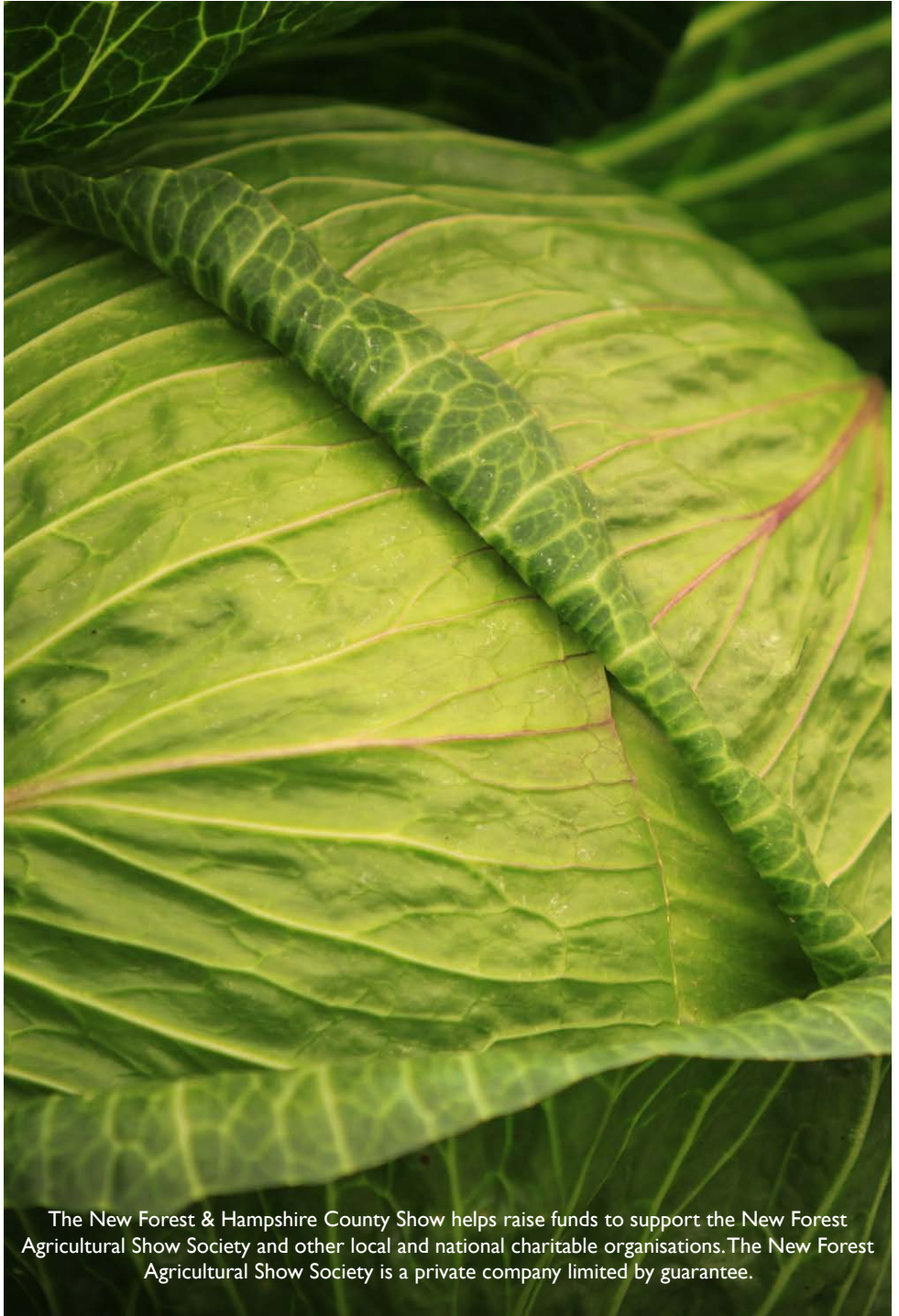
## RULES FOR SECTION A: VEGETABLE CLASSES

1. The Show Secretary reserves the right to refuse entry to any exhibitor without explanation. As per RHS rules.
2. Exhibits will be judged in accordance with the RHS rules where applicable.
3. Staging of exhibits will only be allowed between the hours of 5.00 pm and 11.00 pm on Monday 24th July 2017 and again between the hours of 6.00 am and 8.00 am on Tuesday 25th July 2017, as all exhibitors and vehicles must be removed from the showground before 11.00 pm on the Monday night.
4. Judging will commence at 8.00 am on Tuesday 25th July 2017. Only Judges, Stewards and Officials are allowed to stay in the Marquee during judging. The Show will only open to the general public when Judging has been completed to the satisfaction of the Show Secretary and all the prize cards and rosettes have been awarded and placed on the benches.
5. Prize money vouchers can be collected from the Show Secretary only after all the calculations have been completed to the satisfaction of the Show Secretary and prize cards awarded. Alternatively a cheque can be posted on to the exhibitor. Trophies will be presented at the presentation evening which is free to all NVS members.
6. Entry forms must reach the Show Secretary by the stated time.
7. Closing date for entries will be Wednesday 19th July 2017. No late entries will be accepted (this is because there would insufficient time to process your entry and send out your ticket/car pass).
8. Exhibitors will be allowed entry to the Show during staging by displaying the exhibitors' car park pass. Clearance tickets will be issued by the Show Secretary on the first day of the Show.
9. The handling of exhibits once staged or after judging is forbidden. Under **NO** circumstances will any exhibit be allowed to be removed from the tables once judging has been completed, except by the Show Secretary, until the official lifting time of 4.00pm on Thursday, 27th July 2017. Any exhibits that remain uncollected will be auctioned for charity, auction to start at 4.30pm
10. In section 'A' staging is not provided, with the exception of Class 1. Exhibitors may use their own staging in accordance with RHS guidelines, when using cloths please use black cloths only.
11. Only one entry per Exhibitor per class allowed.
12. Exhibitors entering any collections or large vegetable classes i.e. Top Tray, Master Gardener etc, if you are unable to stage in these classes please can you inform the Show Secretary at least two days prior to the Show as space is limited.

# RULES FOR SECTION B: NVS SOUTHERN BRANCH CHAMPIONSHIPS

1. The Championships are open to all individual NVS members and ONE member of an affiliated Society.
2. Judging will be to the rules laid down by The National Vegetable Society.
3. Staging of exhibits will only be allowed between the hours of 5.00 pm and 11.00 pm on Monday 24th July 2017 and again between the hours of 6.00 am and 8.00 am on Tuesday 25th July 2017, as all exhibitors and vehicles must be removed from the showground before 11.00 pm on the Monday night.
4. Judging will commence at 8.00 am, on Tuesday, 25th July 2017. Only Judges, Stewards and Officials are allowed to stay in the Marquee during judging. The Show will only open to the general public when Judging has been completed to the satisfaction of the Show Secretary and all the prize cards and rosettes have been awarded and placed on the benches.
5. Prize money vouchers can be collected from the Show Secretary only after all the calculations have been completed to the satisfaction of the Show Secretary and prize cards awarded. Alternatively a cheque can be posted on to the exhibitor. Trophies will be presented at the presentation evening which is free to all NVS members.
6. Entry forms must reach the Show Secretary by the stated time.
7. Closing date for entries will be Wednesday 19th July 2017. No late entries will be accepted (this is because there would insufficient time to process your entry and send out your ticket/car pass).
8. Entry to the Show will be by ticket only. One "any day" ticket will be sent out by first class post prior to the event. You will also receive a pass to the Exhibitor's car park and a map of the Showground.
9. The handling of exhibits once staged or after judging is forbidden. Under **NO** circumstances will any exhibit be allowed to be removed from the tables once judging has been completed, except by the Show Secretary until the official lifting time of 4.00pm on Thursday, 27th July 2017. Any exhibits that remain uncollected will be auctioned for charity, auction to start at 4.30pm.
10. All plates, dishes, sand and boards etc will be supplied and must be the ones used. Exhibitors may use own staging for Class 1 and 2.
11. Only one entry per Exhibitor per Class allowed.
12. Exhibitors entering any collections or large vegetable Classes i.e. Cabbages, Celery etc, if you are unable to stage in these classes please can you inform the Show Secretary at least two days prior to the Show as space is limited.
