11. Art
“REFRESH”
 A painting or drawing, any medium, nothing stitched or sewn. This exhibit must be framed and ready to hang, OVERALL WIDTH NO LARGER THAN 14”(35cms) with height appropriate to the design. No clip frames please.

12. Committee Cup (Public Vote)
“RECYCLE”
 A collage no larger than 12” x 12” (30cms x 30cms), using recycled material. Several members to participate. Name of your WI on the back of your exhibit, please.

1. Competitors must be Hampshire WI members and all articles for the competition **MUST** be their own work since August 2016.
2. Entry forms should be sent through Members' Institute Secretary.
3. Competitors can enter any number of items, unless otherwise stated, but can take only one award in each class.
4. The Judge's decision is final. Right is reserved to withhold the first prize if the Judge considers the work does not merit it.

5. All exhibits including Co-operatives must be checked in BETWEEN 9.00am and 11.00am on the day before the Show – Monday, 24th July 2017. **N.B Apart from class 4, no substitutions on the day please.**

6. Exhibits, apart from Class 8, will be staged at the Committee's discretion.
7. Entries close Friday, 9th June 2017.
8. Exhibits may not be dismantled or removed from the Showground until 6.30pm, but before 7.30pm having been CHECKED OUT on the final day, Thursday 27th July 2017.
9. Any Show comments to be sent to Mrs Pauline Slade, Newbridge Farmhouse, Newbridge, Hampshire, SO40 2NW within 14 days of the Show's completion.

CLASSES

1. BISCUITS
 Three identical gluten free biscuits displayed on a board 9" x 4" (23cms x 10cms). No icing or decoration: ingredients to be listed on reverse of tie-on label.

2. JAM
 A small glass jar (no larger than 8oz/225g) of jam prepared from any dried fruit. No mincemeat or fresh fruit to be used. Lids must be plain.

3. CHEESE SCONES
 Three equal sized cheese scones presented on a round plate, no larger than 8" (20cms)

4. Produce Co-operative
VICTORIAN PICNIC BASKET
 Three different items of food, displayed within a basket, any shape, no larger than 15" (38cms). Accessories may only be used within the basket. At least 3 members to take part, but only 2 members to stage on Monday 24th July 2017. Bottles only as accessories (will not be judged). No meat or fish.

5. JEWELLERY
 An item of jewellery made from recycled material.
6. STUFFED TOY
 A stuffed toy, not jointed or wired, made from a recycled jumper or socks.

7. Charity Class
CROSS BODY BAG
 As per pattern supplied. All entries will be donated to Sew Powerful Charity.

8. Craft Co-operative
“SOMETHING OLD, SOMETHING BORROWED, SOMETHING BLUE”
 Three different craft items displayed on a board 30" x 24" (77cms x 61cms), to be viewed from the front. Accessories may be used. Marks will be awarded for staging and interpretation. At least three members to participate, only two to stage on Monday 24th July 2017.

9. FLOWERS
“REUSE”
 A petite FRESH or DRIED flower exhibit using natural plant material, displayed in an item of 'kitchenalia' (e.g. margarine tub, etc). NO tins - entire arrangement no larger than 10" x 10" x 14.5" high (26cms x 26cms x 37 cms). No board. The display to arrive at the Showground ready assembled.

10. Novice Class
Photography
“RENEW”
 The photograph should be no larger than 7" x 5" (18cms x 13cms) and must be mounted, framed and ready to hang. No clip frames. Due to limited space, no more than 2 entries per member, please.
