Please find below the most significant points for the 2019 Show:-

We have introduced a new Veteran Showmanship class, both Dairy and Beef, aimed at handlers aged 27 years or over with no upper age limit. The class will not contribute to the Championship, however animals that have been used in the Junior, Intermediate or Senior classes may be used in this Showmanship class.

We are delighted to have the continued support of Symonds and Sampson LLP with the Hampshire Shows Cattle Championship, now in its ninth year and with increased prize money to fourth place. Please see the classes highlighted with a trophy throughout the Schedule that gain points towards this wonderful Show of Shows Championship. There are an additional five points available this year for taking part in the Grand Parade.

- Tuesday

We are continuing with the success of the multi-breed **Dairy Cattle** classes and look forward to even more entries.

The Dairy Showmanship classes are aimed at our younger cattle handlers as we encourage junior participation in the Cattle classes.

- Wednesday

The traditional **Pedigree Beef** classes will be held.

- Thursday

Forest run cattle are welcomed in to the Commercial Beef and Dairy classes and qualify for the Bert Morgan award.

**For Dexter** competitors the main Dexter showing day is on **Tuesday** and we have Progeny Pairs, Group of Three animals, Non-Exhibitor Bred and Exhibitor Bred classes on **Thursday**.

Overnight camping will continue to be allowed in the parking area adjacent to the cattle marquees within the separate fenced-off area as last year. Under no circumstances will tents be permitted within the vehicle areas of the car park. Exhibitors who wish to sleep inside their vehicles/trailers may do so.
