Size not exceeding 25 cms width, 25 cms depth, 37.5 cms height.

Staged as a class on round tabling, 76cms from the ground covered in black fabric.

Viewed all round and judged from the front.

### **2. THE ROUGH & SMOOTH:A PAVE /TAPESTRY EXHIBIT**

Can be brought ready assembled

Staged as a class on round tabling, 76cms from the ground covered in black fabric.

Space allowed: 35 cms width, 35 cms depth, height optional.

Viewed and judged from the front.

### **3. TEA FOR TWO :A NOVICE EXHIBIT**

Class only open to Exhibitors who have never won a prize in the NFS.

Staged on tabling, 76cms from ground covered in pale green fabric

Space allowed: width 90 cms, depth 69 cms, height optional

Viewed and judged from the front.

### **4. A FEAST FOR THE EYES :AN EXHIBIT**

Viewed and judged from the front.

Staged on a wooden trestle table, 180cm width, 75cm depth, height of table from floor 72cm  
The exhibit may extend over the edge of the table but must not touch the floor  
Competitors must provide their own table covering if required  
Space allowed: 200cm width, 95cm depth, height optional  
Viewed and judged all round.  
Maximum 2 people to stage exhibit.

- 6. HIGH TIDE :AN EXHIBIT to include driftwood**  
Competitors to provide their own stand  
Staged on the ground on a paving slab 45 cms square  
Space allowed 50 cms width, 50 cms depth, 140 cms Minimum height  
Viewed and judged all round  
**Prize 1st £8**  
**CLASS SPONSOR: Catts Tree Care**
- 7. WIND SWEEP: A PEDESTAL EXHIBIT:**  
Competitors to provide their own pedestal.  
Staged on the ground on a brown wooden slab 60 cms square, 5 cms high.  
Space allowed 122cms width, 122cms depth, height optional.  
Viewed and judged from the front.  
**Prize 1st £8**  
**CLASS SPONSOR: Lymington Flower Club**
- 8. MOMENT IN TIME : A NAFAS CLUB EXHIBIT (W & J AREA CLUBS ONLY)**  
Title to be stated.  
Staged on the ground on a wooden base 151 cms square, 9 cms approx. high  
Space allowed 180 cms width, 180 cms depth, 243 cms height.  
Viewed and judged from the front.  
Maximum of 3 people to stage the exhibit.

- 9. FLAMBOYANCE: A STEAM PUNK EXHIBIT**  
NO floral foam to be used. FLORAL FIBRE OR AGRA WOOL MAY BE USED  
Staged on tabling, 76cms from ground covered in pale green fabric  
Space allowed: width 90 cms, depth 69 cms, height optional  
Viewed and judged from the front.

**10. FLIGHT OF FANCY:ART IN THE ENVIRONMENT**

A hanging exhibit to be staged outside marquee - No Protection from weather conditions.

Space allowed: 120 cms width, 120 cms depth, height 120 cms (to include the loop)

Suspended from a crossbar 180 cms from the ground. Competitors to include a secure loop at top of design which will then be hung from Crossbar by a Show Committee Member.

Viewed all round and judged from the front.

Maximum 2 people to stage.

**11. FRAGILE BEAUTY : Craft Class - A Garland -A hanging exhibit**

Must be brought ready assembled with a loop attached at the centre top to be hung from a nail attached to the top of wooden trellis covered in pale green fabric

12 cms maximum width, maximum drop (to include the loop) 100cm

Viewed and judged from the front.

## FLOWER ARRANGEMENT SECTION

### Regulations for Competitors

1. **NOTICE OF ENTRY** – Intending Competitors must give notice in writing, on the form provided by Friday 30th June 2024.
2. **EXHIBITS** in all classes must be the work of the Competitor and must be arranged in the Marquee on Staging Day, with the exception of Classes 1, 2, 10 & 11.
3. Bases and drapes are allowed but must be free standing.
4. Water tap and a power point will be available.
5. **COMPETITORS** may not enter more than one exhibit in each class.
6. **COMPETITORS** may not enter more than three classes.
7. **TICKETS & VEHICLE PASSES** corresponding with the entries will be issued by the Chairman in The Marquee on Staging Day. **COMPETITORS** who have entered 2 classes or more (which must include at least one of classes 3-7 or 9 or 11) will receive ONE vehicle pass and admission for one person for any one day.
8. **COMPETITORS** in Class 5 & 10 will receive ONE vehicle pass and admission for TWO persons for any one day. **COMPETITORS** in Class 8 will receive TWO vehicle passes and admission for THREE persons for any one day.
9. **THE SHOW COMMITTEE** will decide the position of all exhibits.
10. **RECEPTION OF EXHIBITS** – Exhibits will be received from 9.30am to 6.00pm, on the Monday prior to the show and must be finished that evening by 7.00pm. Class 8 to finish by 6.30pm.
11. **WATERING**, if necessary, will be done by the Committee.
12. **ALL VEHICLES** must be removed to the Exhibitors' Car Park, by 8.30am on all Show Days.
13. **REMOVAL OF EXHIBITS**. Exhibits may be removed from 5.00pm on the third day of the Show. All base stands plinths must be left in a clean state.
14. **TROPHIES** to be returned to the Show Office by FRIDAY 13 MAY 2025.
15. **ALL TROPHIES** are perpetual and cannot be won outright.
16. **The DECISION of the JUDGE** shall be final. Protests must be handed, in writing, to the Chairman together with a deposit of £5 before noon on the first day of the Show but such protest will only be considered if referring to some infraction of the rules and if not sustained, the deposit will be forfeited. A Quorum of five, consisting of three Stewards and two Members of the Society's Board of Directors, will consider any such protest and their decision which will be given, if possible, before the close of the Show, shall be final.
17. **SPECIAL NOTICE** – The most careful arrangements will be made for the presentation of all articles on exhibition, but the New Forest Agricultural Show Society will not be responsible for the loss of any exhibits or any damage they may sustain on their way to, during, or from the Exhibition Area.
